



The House & Its Patsy Cline History

Brick-A-thon Campaign: to restore & preserve for future generations

Patsy Cline was an American original. With her sultry voice and sophisticated sound, she brought country music down from the mountains and into the hearts of millions of people. Patsy was one of the first country artist to crossover successfully on both the pop and country charts and, with each successive album, her star grew brighter, culminating in her classic number one smash "Crazy" in 1961.

Patsy, her mother, her brother and sister made their home at 608 South Kent Street from November 1948 to June 1957. It was the family home. The home is significant for telling Patsy Cline's story as it is where she lived with her mother and siblings during the decisive years of her early career; it is where she lived when she signed her first record contract with 4 Star Records, when she debuted in Nashville on the Grand Ole Opry, and when she recorded her trademark song, "Walkin' After Midnight".

The house stands as an important destination for Patsy Cline fans and admirers hoping to know "first hand" the story of Patsy's early years. Her home is already recognized throughout the world as a significant monument along the Patsy Cline pilgrimage. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and the Virginia Landmarks Register. Celebrating Patsy Cline is presently raising funds to rehabilitate the house so it can be opened to the public.
